Interns also create short videos and commercials, usually focused on topics youth are most interested in and be introduced to AI design implementation & tools and VR design & integration.

Position Description: Career Pathways for Undocumented Youth Participants will get hands- on experience for real world employment opportunities and fields through career exploration training. This position is not an actual paid job but an incentivised training regiment designed to equip young people with employable skills, while also providing support through case management and career coaching to help work towards acquiring work authorizations or more.
